



Sink Requirements for Food Use Tenants
(Fats Oils, Grease F.O.G. 2.0)
Miami International

Miami Dade County has implemented a program (FOG 2.0) for proper Fats, Oils and Grease discharge in accordance with both State and Federal EPA requirements.

This bulletin is to make you aware that Simon Property Management is committed to support and enforce the new FOG 2.0 environmental regulations, for new food use tenants, meaning that all hand sinks shall be tied into the grease waste piping system not sanitary. Please be advised that this information shall be clearly noted when preparing your construction documents, share it with your designer, architect and engineer.

In addition, as requested by Miami Dade County DERM department, Simon Property Management is enforcing the installation of a physical sign stating: ***“No Dumping of Grease within Sinks”*** to all existing food use tenants at Miami International Mall.

A link for the new regulations website is noted below, Tenant, Tenant Expeditor and Tenant Architect shall be responsible to verify that any documents posted on line and referenced in this bulletin are correct and up to date.
