DINING PAVILION

Digital Menu Boards Required

(10/31/12)
(Updated 11-16-12)

Per the Design Criteria located on the “Food Café” page; Digital Menu Boards are required for the Dining Pavilion, and shall be integrated into the feature wall design. Menu boards must be built into the architecture of the overall storefront design and should not be applied as an afterthought.

- Internally illuminated menu boards are NOT permitted
- No static graphics or supplemental menu boards are allowed.
- Limited to 4 panels unless approved by Landlord.
- No unfinished backs or data lines to be exposed to public.
- Product logos are not allowed.
- Placement of menu boards should be located so that they do not extend in front of the neutral piper opening and are not placed too far back to read.
- The brightness of the electronic menu board should not be brighter than the storefront.
- Ghost images on the background of Tenant’s name are not allowed.
- All Sign Manufacturer drawings are to be submitted to the Tenant Coordinator for review and approval prior to fabrication.
